DEFINITIONS

Old Testament

- **H2142** *zaw-kar'*: properly to *mark* (so as to be recognized), that is, to *remember*; by implication to *mention*
- **H2143** *zay'-ker*: a *memento*, abstractly *recollection* (rarely if ever); by implication *commemoration*

New Testament

- **G3415** *mnaomai*: to *bear in mind*, that is, *recollect*; by implication to *reward* or *punish*:
- **G3421** *mnēmoneuō*: to *exercise memory*, that is, *recollect*; by implication to *punish*; also to *rehearse*:
